## THE ST VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

*"Charity is certainly greater than any rule. Moreover, all rules must lead to charity".* St Vincent de Paul



The focus of our work at the St Vincent de Paul Society is visiting and befriending people living in isolation and poverty. The people we visit could be refugees, the elderly, the homeless, people staying in hospital or care homes, people with mental health issues or offenders. Conference Members work on the ground level, face-to-face with the people they help. Here are a few statistics highlighting the work of our Conferences at a national level as well as here in St Joseph's last year:

- Over 9,500 members helped 75,000 beneficiaries. Our small group helped 38 beneficiaries.
- 45% of the people we visited were the elderly in their own homes. Locally 40% of those we visit are elderly.
- The Society made over 470,000 visits. We made 359 visits plus 367 transport assistance.
- Material and practical assistance was offered to over 88,000 people and families. We helped 8 beneficiaries on 36 occasions.

The amount raised will feed 55 children who will not only get fed one good, nutritious meal every school day for a whole year, but they will get an education too.

**OLIVE WOOD CARVINGS FROM THE HOLY LAND ON SALE NEXT WEEK:** We are the Good Shepherd Company from Bethlehem which is based in Nottingham. We work alongside St Vincent De Paul for orphans and elderly in the Holy Land. Our goal is to support and help Christian families stay at work as olive wood carving is one of the most important sources of income for them - 90% of Christians rely on their sale. By selling their product here (rosaries, crosses, cribs and religious statues) on their behalf, we help prevent Christians having to leave the country in search of better work opportunities. The craftsmen have a small association which helps to support the poor and needy especially those in need of medical care as there is no welfare system to support them.
