A BILL FOR THE DECRIMINALISATION OF ABORTION:

There is a movement which is attempting to remove all

legal protection for unborn babies and their mothers in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. On 23 October the first step is being taken with a Ten Minute Rule in Parliament. This may lead to clauses being added to the Domestic Abuse Bill. Please be the voice for the unborn and their mothers by contacting your MP requesting them to defeat proposals. Please pick up an explanation sheet with notes on the law as it stands, the possible consequence of the proposal and how to respond in

the Church porches.
