DIOCESAN YEAR OF PRAYER AND VOCATION

October is a month of prayer for our schools, for our young people and their vocation within the church.

The saints to accompany us this month are **St Ignatius** and **Venerable Mary Ward** (patron of our Pastoral Area).

St Ignatius was a bright young man who loved the latest fashion and gossip. He enjoyed socialising with other knights until he was seriously injured in battle. Whilst convalescing he read the lives of the saints and found a fresh challenge in the service of our Lord. At first he had no clear idea of what the outcome of this calling would be or the Congregation of Jesuits he would later form. Gradually he found a deep peace in his heart by seeking to focus each day on orienting his desires and choices to the will of God.

The Venerable Mary Ward from Yorkshire never met St Ignatius but admired his spiritual life and writings. She felt strongly called to establish schools for girls where they could receive quality education. She met with very strong opposition from both the church and the state but persisted in listening to the desire within her to follow God's call.

This month we are asked to set aside a regular time for prayer and, if possible, to do this at the beginning of the day. We might ask for God's grace as we briefly look at the day ahead and then spend time offering it to God.

A BILL FOR THE DECRIMINALISATION OF ABORTION:

There is a movement which is attempting to remove all legal protection for unborn babies and their mothers in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. On 23 October the first step is being taken with a Ten Minute Rule in Parliament. This may lead to clauses being added to the Domestic Abuse Bill. Please be the voice for the unborn and their mothers by contacting your MP requesting them to defeat proposals. Please **sign the petition** which you will find on "Citizengo uk Highjacking Bill to allow Abortion" and/or **write to your MP** to attend on the 23rd and vote against it. An explanation sheet with notes on the law as it stands, the possible consequences of the proposal and how to respond can be found in the Church porches.
