the only novena officially prescribed by the Church. We are all encouraged to join the nine days of prayer in preparation for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon our world. The novena starts on Friday 31 May and ends on the eve of Pentecost 8 June. Prayer cards are available at the back of church.
