Recently, our diocese was the focus of a Safeguarding Audit undertaken by the <u>Catholic Safeguarding Standards</u> Agency (CSSA). The key findings are that we are at the overall grading of <u>Comprehensive Assurance</u> at this time. Exemplary practice was seen in respect of the compassionate and innovative ways in which the diocese seeks to engage with, and support, victim-survivors. Bishop David has issued a Pastoral Message reflecting on our recent audit report from the CSSA.
