This year's theme, chosen by Pope Francis, is 'Artificial Intelligence and the Wisdom of the Heart: Towards a Fully Human Communication'. It is closely linked to his message for the World Day of Peace, which was devoted to the development of systems of artificial intelligence. He says that AI can never replace the wisdom of the human heart.
