INVITATION TO EUCHARISTIC ADORATION: As the summer holidays conclude for most, we transition back into our regular weekly routines. We invite you

EDUCATION SUNDAY is marked on 14 September, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Ten years ago, the then-Holy Father, Pope Francis, said during his Mass for this feast that a Christian "must lower himself, as Jesus lowered himself: this is the path of humility". Catholic education endeavours to acknowledge Jesus' loving presence in the lives of young people as they work, learn, pray, grow in character and virtue, and discover their vocation. This year's theme is drawn from the Gospel reading of John 3:13-17 'The Son of Man must be lifted up'. This Sunday we give thanks for the dedication, example and inspiration of school leaders, teachers, and all who contribute to nurturing and supporting children and young people in our local area. We pray that our school communities be filled with Jesus' compassion, love and joy.

EVANGELII GAUDIUM SUNDAY will be celebrated in parishes on 21 September. This year, the Church has been celebrating a significant anniversary. It's 1,700 years since the Council of Nicaea. This great gathering of Bishops from around the Church began the work to formulate the creed we proclaim Sunday by Sunday. It is the content of this creed that is our mission, so that we may know and love God in this life, in order to be happy with him forever in the next. The creed begins with a profound proclamation, "I believe...". This is the theme for this year. A second collection will be taken to support the work of the Bishops' Conference Department of Evangelisation and Discipleship. Please hold this important work in your prayers.
