PRISONS WEEK celebrates its 50th year by remembering once again that, no matter what your circumstances, or the place in which you stand, God's word is not chained. This week-long ecumenical event, which runs from PRISONERS' SUNDAY on 12 October until Saturday 18 October, aims to raise awareness and encourage prayer for prisoners, their families, victims of crime, and all those involved in or affected by the criminal justice system. This year's theme is "God's word is not chained", based on 2 Timothy 2:9, encouraging prayer for freedom from various forms of bondage, both within and outside of prison.
