There will be a special Mass to remember all our departed family, friends and parishioners in St Joseph's Church at 7:30pm. This will be followed by refreshments in the First Committee Room. All are welcome to attend and pray for those whose passing we mourn.

#### IN NOVEMEMBER WE REMEMBER

The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls. It is a time to remember and pray for our loved ones who have gone before us and whose loss we feel.

**HOLY SOULS:** During November we pray especially for all the Holy Souls: those who have died in the past year, past members of our parish, our own departed relatives and friends and those who have no one to pray for them. As in recent years, we will have the golden Holy Souls box on the altar as from All Souls Day through to the end of November. Parishioners are invited to place names of loved ones in the golden box so we can remember them in our prayers. If you are unable to visit the church, you can send a note to the Parish Office or phone the Priory with names of family or friends you would like to be included.

We are very happy to visit you in your own home and bring you Communion. Please phone us at the Priory if you would like someone to call on you.

**EUCHARISTIC ADORATION** continues throughout November on Monday evenings from 6:30pm to 7pm in St Joseph's Church (including on the Feast of All Souls) and on Thursday mornings after the 9am Mass until 10am. Whether you are available for a few minutes or the full duration, your attendance is valued and offers an opportunity for spiritual renewal.

EMMAUS - OPENING THE SCRIPTURES: Our next talk takes place on Wednesday 5 November in St Joseph's Church. The topic is 'Baptism in the Bible' and the speaker is Deacon Brent Adonis.

The Sacrament of Baptism, rooted in the rich water symbolism of the Old Testament comes to its fulfilment in the saving events of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection as described in the New Testament. Deacon Brent was ordained in 2018 and has served as a Deacon at Saint Dunstan's Bourne End and Saint Teresa's Beaconsfield since then. Brent is actively involved in the preparation of candidates and parents of candidates for Baptism, the First Sacraments and Confirmation as well as Children's Liturgy.
